Ed and Sara – it is difficult at this point to make a firm determination on this. The house is an intact example of a 1927 house with Colonial Revival style elements. However, the 2002 survey report places this building's potential significance not in architecture but in the suburbanization of Rochester Hills which requires more study. We also don't know a lot about the history of the house other than the owner's names from the 1938 rural inventory.

With the limited information we have, the building does not appear to be significant enough to warrant individual historic designation, however further research could determine that the house is important to the 1920s development in Rochester Hills and worthy of designation.
