
RE: NOCWA Contract Re-opener

Dear Ms. McCormick:

NOCWA is pleased to present the following information in regards to our scheduled contract re-opener which will be in place for the next three fiscal years. We request that our next contract utilize a maximum day rate of 49.5 MGD and a peak hour rate of 52.5 MGD. Our requested maximum day rate is a reduction from our existing contract of 50.6 MGD, while our requested peak hour rate remains unchanged.

NOCWA's overall water usage has been consistently decreasing for the past several years, partly due to the reduction in non-revenue water the members have achieved through improvements to their system. Considering NOCWA as a whole, a maximum day contract rate of 49.5 MGD is appropriate when looking at summer demand data going back to 2011. The figure below shows NOCWA's summer daily demands compared to GLWA's total system pumpage going back to 2011. A projection is made out to a GLWA production of 1,000 MGD. A contract maximum day of 49.5 MGD would be in between the straight line projection and one standard deviation.





For the peak hour, NOCWA members believe the existing contract rate of 52.5 MGD is appropriate. The communities with storage have demonstrated that they have adequate control of their systems allowing them to reduce their demand during peak hours. For portions of NOCWA without storage, lawn watering restrictions have been enacted that limit automatic sprinkler systems to run during GLWA's exclusionary period. Through continued effective use of storage and public education, NOCWA believes that their peak hour contract rate can be maintained at 52.5 MGD.
