Please find attached the documents requested by city council as a prerequisite for a resolution of recognition in support of Friends of Romeo High Clay Target Club's application for a Michigan Charitable Gaming Licenses.

A: The organization's current bylaws are attachment "A"

B: A complete file-stamped copy of the organization's Articles of Incorporation as filed with the State of Michigan are attachment "B"

C: The organization's 501 c 3 determination letter from the IRS is attachment "C"

D: Article 2.03 c of the bylaws state that upon dissolution of the organization, all assets will be reverted to one or more other 501 c 3s.

E: Attachment E contains the organization's 2022 990-N e-postcard and a 12 month revenue and expenses statement.

F: Articles 2.01 and 2.03 a and b of the bylaws state that this organization is a 501 c 3 and no action should be taken to change that.

G: The organization's offices are listed in attachment "G"

H: Friends of Romeo High Clay Target Club is organized to provide support for the Target Club at Romeo High School in Washington Township, MI. Support can come in many forms which may include but not limited to; fundraising activities, the filing of grant requests, and the receipt of donations from supportive parties. Funds raised or received may be used to offset the operating cost of the club including equipment, field cost, tournament fees, club promotions, and supplies. All support is to be used strictly for the benefit of members of the Club.

Past fundraising activities have included donations, selling club t-shirts and hats to parents/grandparents, selling target ammunition and fundraising banquets.

I: If licensing is granted by the State of Michigan Charitable Gaming Division, the organization plans to hold one raffle per year in support of the Romeo High Clay Target Club.

J: In December of 2022 the director of the organization authorized the application for a charitable gaming license.

K: Per the organization's CPA, only organizations with over \$25000 of contributions per year are required to file a Solicitation Registration Form with the State of Michigan. Hence, such a form is not required by the state for this organization, nor does it exist.
