Vice President Morita,

The refrigerators are Samsung, which from research is a quality unit with very positive ratings. The GE stoves / ovens as a whole are a little more expensive for a few reasons. First the units are pro-grade which is a step below commercial. Second they are not a "constant pilot" but electric start due to the alerting system shutting off the gas and electric to the unit when we are dispatched. I can speak from experience, from a department that I worked for which had a very serious fire in the kitchen and lounge area that resulted in about \$250,000.00 in damage from unattended cooking.

The GE stoves for Station 2, 3, and 5 are 36" stoves and the hood exhaust and hood fire protection systems are designed for them. The stove currently at Station 1 is a 48" gas constant pilot stove, with the hood exhaust system and hood fire protection system designed for a unit of that size. The cost of a 48" GE pro-grade stove with electric start that met the current system requirements was about \$2500 more than the 36" units we are getting for Station 2, 3, and 5. Hope this answers your questions.
