Benefits

1. Station 5 areas now staffed with two (2) members providing Fire and BLS coverage 24-hours a day.
2. Reduces response times to Station 5 area by up to twelve (12) minutes between the hours of 23:00 and 06:00. (Fire and BLS Coverage only)
3. Outside stations for the exception of Station 5, staffed with three (3) members each.
4. Fire coverage provided 24-hours a day for Station 5.
5. ALS coverage response times to Station 3 area reduced

ALS Response Times to Station 3 potentially reduced by the following:

Issues

1. One (1) ALS Unit still with out three (3) members

2. Fire and Basic Life Support coverage only with (2) two members in Station 5 area.
3. Advanced Life Support Unit on-scene time for Station 5 area between 8 to 13 minutes.
