**SUBJECT:** Cross Connection Control Plan for the City of Rochester Hills

**REQUEST:**

City Council approve the Cross Connection Control Plan and once approved by Council, allow HydroCorp, Inc., to submit the Plan to the MDEQ, on behalf of the City, for their approval.

**BACKGROUND:**

In accordance to the requirements set forth by the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ), the City of Rochester Hills has officially adopted the state of Michigan cross connection rules to protect the public water system. A cross connection is defined as a connection or arrangement of piping or appurtenances through which a backflow could occur. Backflow is defined as the undesirable reversal of flow of water of questionable quality, wastes or other contaminants into a public water supply. The purpose of this program is to avoid contamination of the public water supply by preventing and eliminating cross connections. It is the City of Rochester Hills' intent to carry out a comprehensive and effective cross connection control program (CCCP) to ensure public health is protected and the requirements of the Michigan State Drinking Water Act are complied with. The authority to carry out and enforce our CCCP is provided from our local ordinances, the Michigan Safe Drinking Water Act (Act 399), the MDEQ, Water Bureau Cross Connection Rules Manual and the Michigan Plumbing Code.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

City Council approve the Cross Connection Control Plan presented.
