REQUEST:

The Department of Public Services recommends accepting the bid and awarding of a contract for the *2014 Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation Project* to Liqui-Force Services (USA) Inc. of Romulus, Michigan as the lowest, most responsive, responsible bidder in the amount \$586,600.91 and authorize the Mayor to execute a contract on behalf of the City.

The Department of Public Services also requests City Council authorization of a 10% contingency in the amount of \$58,660.09 to allow for quantity adjustments based on final measurements verified in the field.

REASON FOR PURCHASE:

On February 18, 2014 the City received one (1) sealed bid for the *2014 Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation Project*. See attached bid tab. Construction is expected to commence April 2014 with final completion no later than 90 days after the Notice to Proceed.

Through routine televising, sanitary sewer locations in various stages of deterioration were cataloged and identified for rehabilitation. The majority of the proposed work will be prosecuted through a non-destructive method called cured-in-place sewer lining, isolated segment lining, joint grouting and manhole repairs. The work is located in several locations throughout the City.

This project includes a grant the City received from Wayne County through the Rouge River National Wet Weather Demonstration Project (Round XI) to perform a sanitary sewer rehabilitation project in the southwest portion of the City. Wayne County will reimburse the City \$36,240 from the grant. The agreement between the City and Wayne County was approved in December 2012.
