Petition forms available from DNR. The petition will be valid for a 5 yr period, though the applicant must apply annually for the program. Copy of signed petition must be on file with DNR
kJ	Business: An institution, corporation, or other entity which owns/controls all lands surrounding or containing the subject lake/body of water/site. This can include golf courses, apartments/condos, parks, and recreation areas.
	Sole Owner: Applicant is an individual with sole ownership and control of the subject lake/body of water/site, with no public access.
