ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ARTICLE VIII OF CHAPTER 54, FEES, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF ROCHESTER HILLS, OAKLAND COUNTY, MICHIGAN, TO INCREASE PARK ENTRY AND SHELTER AND SPORTS FIELD RENTAL FEES, REPEAL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES AND PRESCRIBE A PENALTY FOR VIOLATIONS.

THE CITY OF ROCHESTER HILLS ORDAINS:

Section 1. Article VIII of Chapter 54 of the Code of Ordinances shall be amended, as follows:

ARTICLE VIII. PARKS AND RECREATION

Sec. 54-466. Spencer Park motor vehicle entry fees.

The following schedule of motor vehicle entry fees shall apply only to Spencer Park. There shall be no charge for bicycles ridden into the park or for pedestrians. (Note: Status of residency to obtain the resident discount shall be determined by the vehicle registration.)

- (1) Annual membership permit.....\$~~50.00~~60.00
- (2) Resident discount on annual membership permit~~25.00~~30.00
- (3) Daily permit10.00
- (4) Resident discount on daily permit.....5.00
- (5) Senior citizen (at least 60 years of age) and handicap annual permit pass
.....~~10.00~~20.00
- (6) Resident discount on senior citizen (at least 60 years of age) and handicap annual permit pass~~5.00~~10.00
- (7) Bus rate (11 passenger or greater capacity), twice the ~~established~~ annual permit fee.
- (8) Off-season daily permit (October 15 – May 15).....5.00
- (9) Resident discounted off-season daily permit3.00

Sec. 54-467. Bloomer Park and Yates Park motor vehicle entry fees.

The following schedule of motor vehicle entry fees shall apply to Bloomer Park and Yates Park. There shall be no charge for bicycles ridden into the park or for pedestrians. Annual memberships permits and senior citizen and handicap permits passes shall be honored at Bloomer Park and Yates Park.

- (1) Bloomer/Yates annual permit pass\$~~25.00~~30.00
- (2) Bloomer/Yates daily permit.....5.00

- (3) Bus rate (11 passenger or greater capacity), twice the ~~established~~ annual permit fee.

Sec. 54-468. Daily shelter rental.

The fees for daily shelter rental, not including motor vehicle entry fee, shall be:

(1) Stone Shelter	\$ 200.00 <u>225.00</u>

Sec. 54-469. Commercial use of park grounds.

The fees for commercial use of park grounds shall be as follows:

(1) One-half day (up to four hours)	\$300.00
(2) Full day (four to eight hours)	600.00

Sec. 54-470. Museum and environmental education center.

The following schedule of fees shall apply to the Rochester Hills Museum at Van Hoosen Farm, the Dairy Barn Facility, and the Rochester Hills Environmental Education Center:

Section 2. Severability. This ordinance and each article, section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph, part, provision, sentence, word and portion thereof are hereby declared to be severable, and if they or any of them are declared to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason by a court of competent jurisdiction, it is hereby provided that the remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected thereby.

Section 3. Penalty. All violations of this ordinance shall be misdemeanors and upon conviction thereof shall be punishable by a sentence of not more than ninety (90) days of confinement to jail or by a fine of not more than \$500, or both, in the court's discretion.

Section 4. Repeal, Effective Date, Adoption.

(1) Repeal. All regulatory provisions contained in other City ordinances, which are inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance, are hereby repealed.

(2) Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective on _____, following its publication in the *Rochester Post* on _____, 2009.

(3) Adoption. This ordinance was adopted by the City Council of the City of Rochester Hills at a meeting thereof held on _____, 2009.
