Request for Purchase Authorization - PARKS: Contract/Blanket Purchase Order for the purchase and implementation of a Recreation Management Software Solution for a project budget in the amount of \$85,000.00; CivicPlus, Manhattan, KS

**Resolved**, that the Rochester Hills City Council hereby waives Section 2-273(b) the 3-year requirement for long term contracts, under Section 2-281, which allows City Council the authority to waive any regulation or procedure pertaining to purchasing, deeming it to be in the best interest of the City to allow a 5-year contract.

**Further Resolved**, that the Rochester Hills City Council hereby authorizes the award of a contract/blanket purchase order for the purchase and implementation of a Recreation Management Software Solution to CivicPlus, Manhattan, Kansas for a project budget amount of \$85,000.00 for a 5-year contract term and further authorizes the Mayor to execute an agreement on behalf of the City.

**Further Resolved**, that the City's acceptance of the proposal and approval of the award of a contract shall be contingent and conditioned upon the parties' entry into and execution of a written agreement acceptable to the City.
