## FY 2011 1st Quarter Budget Amendments

Whereas, in accordance with the provisions of Public Act 2 of 1968, the Uniform Budgeting and Accounting Act, and the Charter for the City of Rochester Hills, Chapter III Section 3.7, the City Council may amend the budget during the fiscal year, either on its own initiative or upon recommendation of the Mayor; and

Whereas, in accordance with Section 19 of Public Act 2 of 1968, the Uniform Budgeting and Accounting Act the City Council may permit the Mayor to execute adjustments to the budget within limits;

Whereas, the Public Hearing for the proposed $20111^{\text {st }}$ Quarter Budget Amendments was noticed on February 3, 2011; and

Whereas, the proposed $20111^{\text {st }}$ Quarter Budget Amendments were available for public viewing beginning on February 18, 2011; and

Whereas, at its February 28, 2011 meeting City Council held a Public Hearing on the proposed $1^{\text {st }}$ Quarter Budget Amendments.
