## **City of Rochester Hills – Community Survey**

Survey Methodology\*

Length	17 minutes
Target Respondents	City of Rochester Hills voters
Survey Fielding	May 30 – June 12, 2025
Margin of Error	+/-5%
Survey Participants	400

#### Sample

The sample was secured through the voter file originally compiled by the Oakland County Elections Division. We mailed, called, emailed, and texted voters. We matched the demographics of City of Rochester Hills voters.

#### **Data Collection Explained**

Interviews were conducted with live interviewers by phone (16%) and online survey methods (84%). Phone participants were interviewed through landline (22%) and mobile (78%) calls. Online participants were invited by email (5%), text message (15%), and mail (79%) to access the survey by computer, tablet, or smart phone.

Respondents in all modes chose their preferred language, English (98%) and Spanish (2%).

Security measures precluded individuals from completing the survey more than once.

\*Due to rounding, totals shown on charts may not add up to 100%

When comparing to other communities, unsure responses were removed to maintain consistency in reporting to other communities
