# Camp Safari at RARA

### 8-week camp from June 16 to August 15

Camp Safari continued to grow and thrive, offering unforgettable experiences for campers and families.

### Maintained popular pickup locations

Convenient transportation options at Northridge Apartments, Rochester Estates, and Hampton Elementary helped ensure access to camp.

### Average of 19 campers per week

Totaling around 150 Camp Safari participants, an increase of over 55 campers from last summer.

### Affordable cost of \$20 per child per week

Allowed families to choose the weeks that worked best for them, whether it was just one or the full eight.
