SUBJECT: PY 2026 CDBG Application

REQUEST:

That City Council is requested to conduct a public hearing and adopt program allocations for the Program Year (PY) 2026 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) application.

REASON FOR PURCHASE:

As part of the application process for CDBG funds, communities must hold a public hearing and the governing body must pass a resolution approving the planned use of funds. Oakland County's Community & Home Improvement Division does not yet have information on the exact amount of PY 2026 funding. The City of Rochester Hills is applying to the County with an initial planning allocation of \$211,500, based on community need, past allocations, and program year spending. The City must allocate funds to eligible programs and projects in accordance with federal and county rules and regulations. The national objectives of the CDBG program are to assist low and moderate-income persons, to prevent or eliminate slums and blight, and to meet an urgent community need where no other funding is available.

The City of Rochester Hills has scheduled a public hearing on October 20, 2025, regarding the PY 2026 CDBG application and proposed funding allocations. The Community & Home Improvement Division has advised Administration that any City Council member who serves on a board of an organization receiving funds should excuse themselves from voting on the resolution. The Community & Home Improvement Division also recommends that organizations requesting funding and wishing to address City Council, should address Council during the public hearing.

In order to comply with federal regulations, the Community & Home Improvement Division is limiting the Public Services Cap at 15% of the total allocation. As a result, the City is applying 85% of the allocation to: Minor Home Repair – Housing (\$180,000) and the remaining 15% to Yard Services - Public Services (\$16,500) and Services for Victims of Domestic Violence, Dating Violence, Sexual Assault or Stalking - Public Services (\$15,000).

Please see the attachment for funding from PY 2022-2024, the proposed amounts for PY 2025 and PY 2026, and the residents serviced with each program. The City has not received funding for PY 2025 at this time so that is the allocation from the application.

Administration is asking City Council to approve the allocation of funding.

\$180,000 **Minor Home Repair (731227)** – Provide accessibility modifications, ordinance compliance, and health and safety related repairs to low-income residents. Eligible repairs include, but

are not limited to, furnace or water heater replacements, roof repairs, plumbing, and electrical.

\$ 31,500 Public Services:

\$16,500 Public Services / Yard Services (732170) – Snow removal and other yard services for low-income senior or disabled adult households.

\$15,000 Public Services / Services for Victims of Domestic Violence, Dating Violence, Sexual Assault or Stalking (730137) – Provide programs such as emergency shelter, legal, and counseling services for domestic violence victims or families.
