SUBJECT: HAWK Signal Agreement – N. Adams Rd. and Baypoint Drive

REQUEST:

The Department of Public Services recommends that City Council approves the agreement between the Road Commission for Oakland County (RCOC) and the City of Rochester Hills for the installation, operations, and maintenance of the proposed HAWK signal at the intersection of N. Adams Rd. and Baypoint Drive and further authorizes the Mayor to execute the agreement on behalf of the City.

REASON FOR PURCHASE:

The proposed HAWK signal has been recommended for installation at the intersection of N. Adams Rd. and Baypoint Drive and the future entrance to Nowicki Park, to provide safe crossing for pedestrians and bicyclists. The City of Rochester Hills will cover the installation and maintenance costs for the HAWK signal.

Costs associated with the installation of the HAWK signal will be covered under the Nowicki Park project. The City will be responsible for 100% of the operation and maintenance of the signal.
