SUBJECT: Acceptance of FY26 One Time Enhancement Grant

REQUEST:

The City requests that City Council accept the terms of the Michigan Department of Labor and Economic Opportunity FY26 One Time Enhancement Grant, Grant #E20260105 for \$2,000,000.00 for roadway infrastructure and a community gathering space at Nowicki Park and further authorizes the Mayor to execute the agreement on behalf of the City.

REASON FOR PURCHASE:

This grant agreement is between the Michigan Department of Labor and Economic Opportunity (LEO) and the City of Rochester Hills. This request seeks City Council approval to accept the FY26 One-Time Enhancement Grant (Grant #E20260105). This state-funded grant provides \$2,000,000 in legislatively directed spending for the City of Rochester Hills. The grant is specifically earmarked to fund critical roadway infrastructure improvements on Adams Road and the development of a community gathering space at Nowicki Park. These improvements will address infrastructure needs to provide safe and efficient roadway access to the new park and construct an indoor community room designed for public gatherings and municipal programming. The grant period runs through September 30, 2030 allowing the City to leverage state dollars and complete this project.
