SUBJECT: Approval of Bilateral Telecommunications METRO ACT Right-of-Way Use Permit For Metro Fibernet

REQUEST:

City Council is asked to approve a new METRO Act Telecommunications Right-of-Way Use Permit (Bilateral Form) for Metro Fibernet.

BACKGROUND:

Metro Fibernet, a Michigan LLC company, proposes to install underground fiber-optic lines using directional bore and trenching methods. The fiber is to be installed in conduit and is expected to be installed in the entirety of the City. These fiber optic lines will be available for use by residents desiring fiber optic-based broadband connections. DPS/Engineering has reviewed the request and has no objections.

DPS recommends Council approval according to METRO Act regulations. The Metropolitan Extension Telecommunications Rights-of-Way Oversight Act (“METRO Act”), 2002 PA 48, governs the telecommunications right-of-way permitting process, and prescribes uniform fees, conditions and permit forms. Fees payable by the permittee under the METRO Act are based on linear feet. The State annually redistributes all the fees it collects to municipalities statewide in accordance with the Act 51 formula.

Metro Fibernet LLC will be required to submit the \$500.00 application fee and all accompanying documents in approved formats. The City’s annual METRO Act revenue increases per linear foot of communications conduit installed within our Rights-of-Way.

RECOMMENDATION:

City Council is asked to approve the Metro Fibernet LLC telecommunications right-of-way use permit, for the first 15-year term, by approving a new Telecommunications Permit (Bilateral form).
