SUBJECT: Nowicki Park Play Area Project

REQUEST:

City Council is requested to authorize a contract/blanket purchase order for the purchase and installation of the Nowicki Park Play Area in the amount of \$2,202,347.00 with a 10% project contingency in the amount of \$220,234.70 for a total not-to exceed project amount of \$2,422,581.70 to Michigan Playgrounds LLC., dba Midstates Recreation, Pataskala, Ohio and further authorizes the Mayor to execute an agreement on behalf of the City.

REASON FOR PURCHASE:

The City issued a Request for Statement of Qualifications (SOQ) for the Design and Construction of a Play Area at Nowicki Park. The City received nine (9) responses. Responses received were evaluated by a committee consisting of Parks staff and the City's Engineer of Record for Nowicki Park with a focus on the following criteria: firm qualifications and team experience, relevant project experience, project understanding and design approach, innovation and sustainability, community engagement strategy, project schedule and capacity, workload and resource management, clarity and completeness of response to SOQ, and references and past performance.

Based on the evaluation process, Midstates Recreation was selected as the most qualified proposer and the City entered negotiations with Midstates Recreation for the Design Phase of this project. Through the Invitation for Negotiation process, Midstates Recreation provided a response to the City's request with a zero-cost proposal to provide the required design services for the Play Area. They indicated that this is a value-add service they provide as part of their business model. The City entered into an agreement with Midstates Recreation to begin the design phase for the Nowicki Park Play Area.

For the past several months, the City has engaged in many meetings with Midstates Recreation, Nowak and Fraus (the City's Engineer of Record for Nowicki Park) and A3C (the City's Architect of Record for Nowicki Park) for the design of the Nowicki Park Play Area and has been extremely satisfied with the demonstrated cooperation and partnership between all the firms and their coordination with the City on this project. What is presented before City Council this evening, is the request for approval of the required goods and services for the successful purchase and installation for completion of the Nowicki Park Play Area. It is requested that City Council authorize award of a contract to Midstates Recreation for the purchase and installation required for the Nowicki Park Play Area.
