Nomination Form – Advisory Traffic & Safety Board

1. President **opens** the floor for nominations
(Each Council Member may nominate 1 candidate. No second required)

2. When nominations are completed, President **closes** the floor for nominations.
3. President specifies names of nominees and calls for a **Roll Call Vote** for Council Members to indicate their choice.

(Majority Vote is elected. If no majority vote, nominee with fewest numbers of votes is dropped and voting continues until 1 nominee receives the majority vote.)

4. President announces nominee appointed to the Advisory Traffic & Safety Board for a one-year term to expire November 30, 2025.

ALTERNATIVE PROCEDURE:

If Council discussion narrows nominees down to one, and Council agrees, President may announce the nominee was appointed to the Advisory Traffic & Safety Board.
